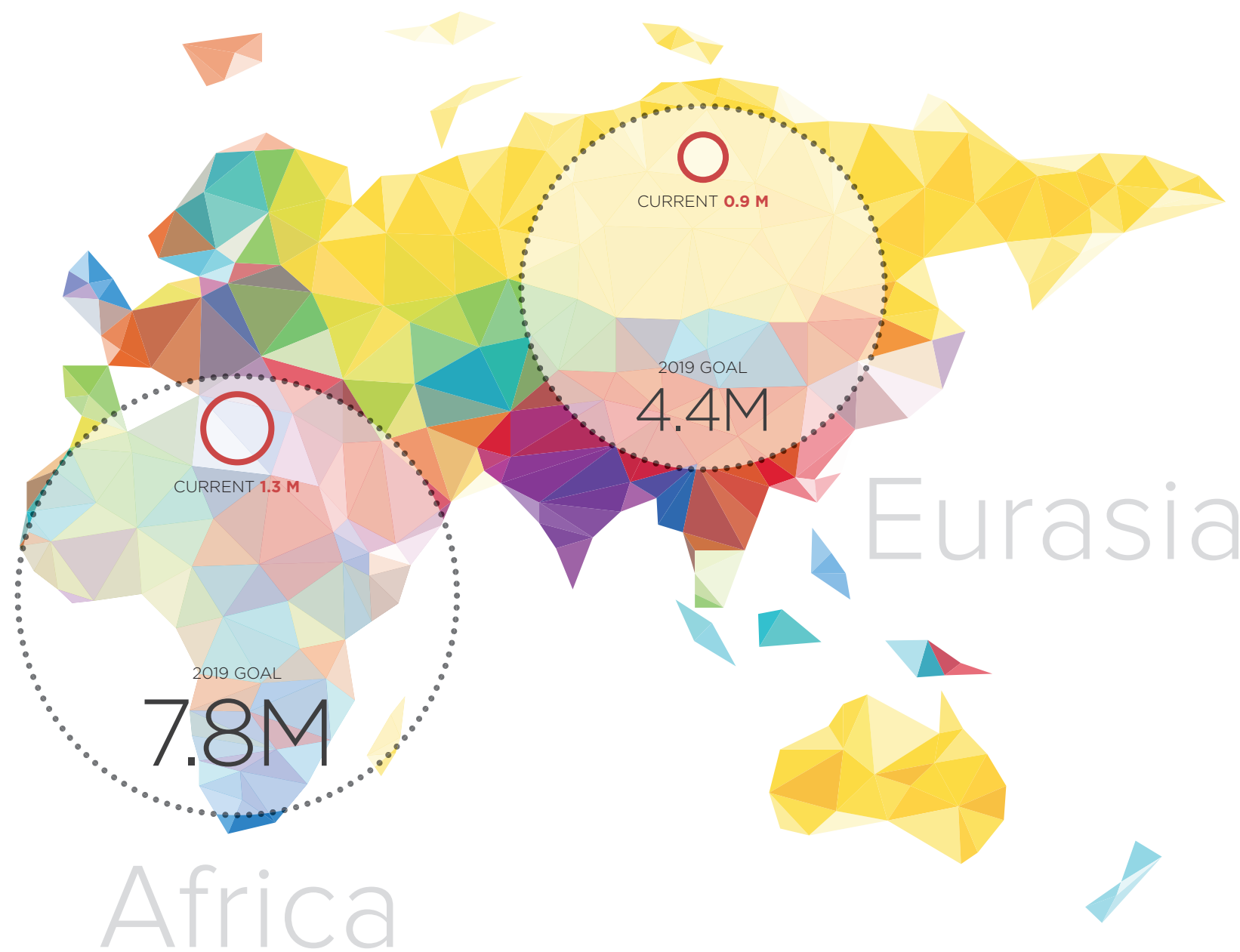
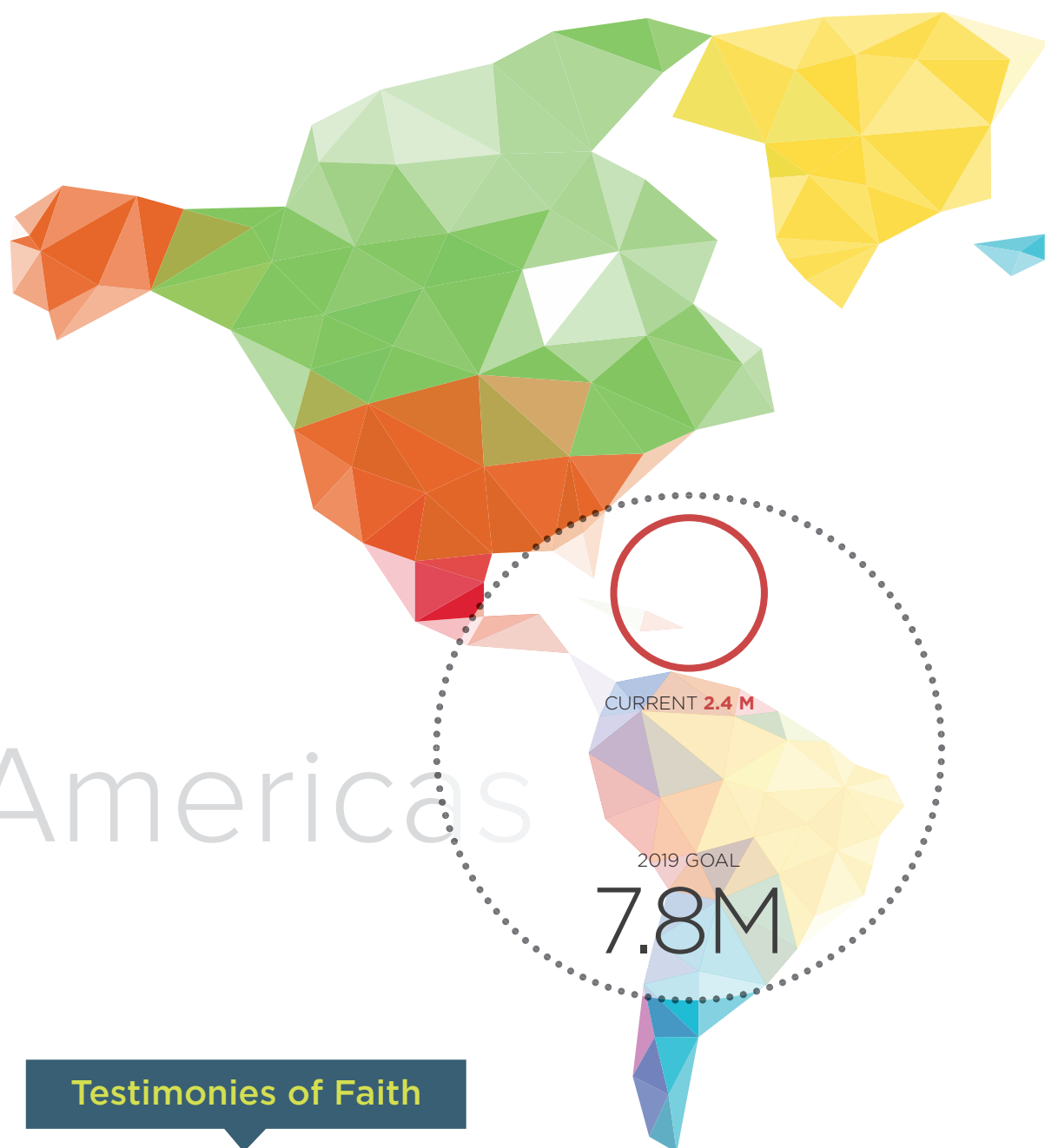

Churches are equipped to make disciples

MEXICO Veronica teaches The Greatest Journey to children at the same orphanage where she once lived. "I want these kids to learn that there's Someone who's going to love them, Someone who's never going to leave them," she said. "One day they can teach other kids about God, and make this a generation that will change the world."

PERU "In my life, I've decided to be a light in the darkness," said 13-year-old Luis Peña. "I want to give that light to those who are lost and I want them to have that light so that they can share it with others."



Nations are transformed

LIBERIA "I used to see other leaders as separate from me," said Pastor Wallace. "But as God called us together to disciple the children of our nation through The Greatest Journey, He pulled down those walls of division. We now plan and pray as a community of faith for the discipling of our children and the transformation of our nation."

FIJI A group of 15 boys and girls accepted Christ during the study of The Greatest Journey and invited their friends to take the course. As more children enrolled in The Greatest Journey, over 700 accepted Jesus Christ and four new village churches were formed.



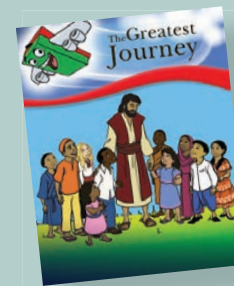

Sharing the Gospel through Operation Christmas Child



In 1993, Samaritan's Purse launched a unique Gospel outreach to children called Operation Christmas Child. What began as a ministry to share gift boxes and the Good News with 28,000 suffering children in Bosnia has grown into a dynamic global campaign that has impacted more than 113 million boys and girls in 150 nations.

Follow-up Discipleship through The Greatest Journey



We developed The Greatest Journey to disciple children who have received shoebox gifts. Working through local churches and trained teachers, we walk them through the Bible from creation to the Cross, invite them to trust Jesus as their Savior, and prepare them to share the Gospel with friends and families. Since 2010, more than 4.6 million children in 96 countries have enrolled and 2 million have made professions of faith in Christ.
